SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hudkins.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. Whether we prefer a railroad type fence or a legal type fence, I have a problem with this particular amendment on this type of bill, and I would like a ruling from the Chair as to whether this particular amendment is germane to this bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Hudkins, would you just briefly state to me why you think it may not be germane? And then, Senator Tyson, I'm going to ask you to respond. And I'll be listening, but I'd like your points first.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Yes. Thank you. The bill, the way I understand its main point, is having to do with personal watercraft, i.e., jet skis and that type of water equipment, and the amendment has to do with fencing. And I don't believe that that is the same thing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Tyson, I'm going to ask for your response.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. LB 176 deals with recreational affairs and the regulation thereof. The Cowboy Trail is a recreational affair. There's very little water on the Cowboy Trail, I'll give you that, but I think, broadly interpreted...this needs to go somewhere. I think it is in a recreational field, generally, and I would rely on that. Oh yeah, that's...I was just reminded, thanks to Senator Beutler, that the trail development bill was attached on a previous amendment to this, and was germane.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock, I...since you had the last amendment, I need some instruction from you. We'll stand at ease while I take a look at it. Senator Schrock, if you'd please help me. Thank you.
