SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Pedersen a question.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Pedersen?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Pedersen, did you say that the inmate would have the right to ask for an outside test in this situation?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes. For his...for a confirmation.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If it were granted, what would keep the inmate from running away, if he were outside? (Laugh) I'm just curious.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: I'm sure the shackles and the guns and the towers and a few other things would probably keep him from...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. With that assurance, I'm going to support this amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Pedersen, you're recognized to close. Senator Pedersen waives closing. The question is the adoption of Amendment 1588 to LB 865. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, on the adoption of Senator Pedersen's amendment.
