SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Further debate on the Wehrbein amendment? He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Wehrbein amendment to LB 637A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Wehrbein amendment is adopted.
