CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 179-180.)
37 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of temporary rules, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The temporary rules are adopted. Before I recognize the Speaker, Senator Kremer would like to announce that the doughnuts are provided today in honor of his 64th birthday, which occurred on January 8th, last Saturday. Senator Kremer, happy birthday. Chair recognizes Speaker Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I've had considerable inquiry about the schedule of what the Legislature may do over the next day and the schedule that I will propose to you and will be out in agenda form is that we would meet tomorrow morning at nine o'clock for the purposes of considering a resolution that's going to be filed concerning Senator Crosby and her late husband, Bob. Then we would recess until three o'clock tomorrow afternoon, come back at three o'clock and work a short period of time tomorrow afternoon. But that would be a recess.
