Senator Kristensen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You are recognized, Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I'd move the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen moves the bill. The question before the body is, shall LB 534 be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 534.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 534 does advance. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, some items, if I may. Your Committee on Health and Human Services reports LB 220 to General File with amendments, and LB 209 indefinitely postponed, that's signed by Senator Jensen.

Mr. President, new bills. (Read LB 1293-1305 by title for the first time.) That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 320-323.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 523 introduced by Senator Suttle. (Read title.) It was introduced on January 19 of last year, at that time referred to the Health Committee. The bill was advanced to General File.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Suttle, you are recognized to open on LB 523.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you, Mr. President, and members of the Legislature. This is a bill that has had some trouble and I think we have worked out most of the trouble. Let me give you
