Human Services Committee. All those in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, Madam Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 440.) 33 ayes, 1 nay on adoption of the Health and Human Services Committee confirmation report, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Report is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, proceeding to Select File, this morning the first bill up this morning is LB 480. Senator Smith, I do have Enrollment and Review amendments on that piece of legislation, Senator. (AM7162, Legislative Journal page 328.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 480.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the E & R amendments say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first amendment to the bill this morning, Senator Schimek, I have AM1957 in front of me, Senator. (AM1957, Legislative Journal page 417.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

CLERK: Senator, AM1957 is the first one I have.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you. Is that page 417?

CLERK: Yes, it is.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This should be one of these amendments that we don't have to have a lot of debate on, but you never know. This actually is an amendment which does not expand the council under the Women's Initiative. It gives an either/or choice and, at present, there are physician...or there are nurse practitioners listed for the council. This would make the choice either a nurse practitioner or a physician's assistant. And I had
