SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Chairman. I wasn't listening. You're talking about LB 1373?

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes, Senator.

SENATOR VRTISKA: We're withdrawing it because we found out there was some error in the way it was designed, and so there is no need for the bill. So I'm asking it to be...I'm asking for consent to withdraw. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the motion to withdraw? Seeing none, Senator Vrtiska, you are recognized for the opportunity to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is, shall we adopt the motion to withdraw LB 1373? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to withdraw LB 1373.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The motion is adopted, LB 1373 is withdrawn. We next move to Select File, LB 477.

CLERK: LB 477, Mr. President. Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to adopt the E & R amendments.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 477.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the motion. The question before the body is the adoption of the E & R amendments. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend. (AM2109, Legislative Journal page 458.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler, you are recognized to open on your amendment.
