But each day that we're on this bill is a day gone and that we're not on other things. And when the Governor starts bringing this stuff in here, where he has told you, you got to vote for what he wants on the budget, and there is no money for any program of yours, oh, I'm going to have fun on that, because you're going to run out of time. And you're going to be running around here trying to scare up every vote you can get, and some of you are going to be coming to me, saying, Ernie can you help me?
