SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Bohlke, you asked for a point of personal privilege for a brief announcement.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes, thank you, Madam President. Members, as you remember, last year, during the time that we...the state aid was announced, you all received notebooks, I'm sure you all know exactly and precisely where those are, that explain what happened to your individual districts. As you go home this weekend, I had had a couple of questions. I asked the Department of Education to put together the sheets that are being handed out to you now. They also will be available today, from 12:30 until 2:00, in Room 2102, if you have any questions. What this piece of paper does is look at your schools. It tells what they got in motor vehicle receipts, more or less than last year, what they got in other receipts, and what happened to their valuation and their student count. As you remember, those are the main things that could change and have an impact on schools. Page 8, if you look, has an example, Scottsbluff, I know that they had some questions. In actual receipts they were up, they were up in other receipts, they were up a great deal in valuation, and they lost 110 students. So, if you have this in hand and have any questions before you go home, the Department of Education, I will repeat, will be in Room 2102, that's across from the Speaker's Office, from 12:30 until two o'clock today. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Bohlke. Mr. Clerk, do you have items for the record?

CLERK: I do, Madam President, thank you. Senator Aguilar has selected LB 557 as his priority bill; Senator Schrock, LB 1234; and Senator Schimek, as one of the Government Committee bills, LB 1135.
