SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I request...

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a board vote. All in favor of the advancement of LB 729 to E & R Initial vote aye, opposed nay...for engrossment, E & R for engrossing, pardon me. All in favor of LB 729 advancing to E & R for engrossing please vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Mr. President, I think I need another vote. (Laugh)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I think I might have to ask for a roll call vote possibly here and a call of the house.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You request a call of the house?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President,

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel leave the floor. All unexcused senators please check in. Senator Bohlke, would you please check in. Senator Suttle, Senator Tyson, please check in. Thank you. Senator Coordsen, Senator Raikes. The house is under call. Senator Raikes, would you please check in. All present or accounted for. Mr. Clerk, there's been a request for a roll call vote. Proceed.
