So there is an approximately, in this two year, with a three year program, but within the three year...two years looking out, it's about \$17,000 General Fund hit, and about \$33,000, \$34,000 Cash Fund hit, and the third year will be in the future, for a total of \$75,000, which would make about \$25,000 General Fund when it's done, that would be a third, and two-thirds of it would be Cash Funds. This is a building that fits very well with the Arbor Lodge historical park at Nebraska City. It provides maintenance facilities now for them that will be away from Arbor Lodge. It's in close proximity, but it will now not be necessary to use the present carriage house for repair and maintenance of the facility; this structure can be used for that, the one that is being gifted to us. And so this resolution accepts that, but I understand that LB 1273 will have to also be passed in due time so that we can accept the gift from the federal government. Right now that is not clear in statute. And we feel that this fits in well with the future mission of Arbor Lodge State Park. It...much of this work in that \$75,000 may be done in-house and may reduce that cost accordingly, but that is the general proposal at this point.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wehrbein. We are now open for discussion on adoption of LR 296. Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Senator Wehrbein, could I ask you a question?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you yield, Senator Wehrbein?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, pardon me, I didn't catch...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Wehrbein, you know, just discussed this last gift and you indicated that there would be some money to upgrade these buildings. That's not going to be...I guess I...my question is, is that going to be General Fund or money outside of the 309 Fund that we manage? In the past we've always taken the position that the 309 Task Force, if they're going to be called in, want to take a look at the building
