CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The committee amendments are adopted. Before we proceed to debate on the bill, items for the record.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Hearing notices from the Health and Human Services Committee; those signed by Senator Jensen as Chair. Judiciary also offers a hearing notice, signed by Senator Brashear as Chair. Confirmation report from Business and Labor Committee. Your Committee on Judiciary reports LB 966 to General File; LB 1013, General File; and LB 94, LB 98, LB 190, LB 222, LB 343, LB 633, to...as indefinitely postponed. Agriculture Committee reports LB 1052 to General File with amendments. Business and Labor reports LB 915 to General File; LB 1310, General File; LB 1424 General File; those reports signed by all the respective chairs. And, Mr. President, motion from Senator Vrtiska will be laid over with respect to the introduction of the Claims bills, Request Number 2098, 2099, by the Business and Labor Committee.
