PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Bromm, would you like to close? The question is suspension of the rules. It does require 30 votes. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to suspend the notice of hearing provision.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is agreed to. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, thank you. Pursuant to that action, I have notice of cancellation of hearing from the Transportation Committee signed by Senator Bromm. I have a communication from the Governor withdrawing the name Mr. Greg Wright for appointment to the Rail and Transit Advisory Council; a subsequent appointment by the Governor to that board, and a reference report referring the new appointee to Transportation Committee for purposes of confirmation hearing.

Mr. President, in addition to those items, a hearing notice from the Natural Resources Committee. Priority bill designations by the Business and Labor Committee, LB 953 and LB 1221. Enrollment and Review reports LB 701 and LB 204 to Select File. Priority bill designations by Senator Raikes, LB 715; and Senator Schmitt, an amendment to LB 901 to be printed. Finally, Mr. President, a series of adds: Senator Schimek, to LB 1004; Senator Vrtiska, to LB 1044; Senator Redfield, LB 1026; Senator Dickey, to LB 1348; and Senator Smith would like to remove his name from LB 1394 and LB 1234. That's all that I have, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 592-597.)
