SENATOR COORDSEN: Is 12 through...

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...12 through 14,...

SENATOR COORDSEN: ...14.

SENATOR JANSSEN: ...right?

SENATOR COORDSEN: Which is a definition.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: It was felt that that was language that was not necessary to identify the farm site or the farm home site.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Because it's carried, if you'll notice, it says "portion of land contiguous to land actively devoted to agriculture".

SENATOR JANSSEN: Right.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Okay?

SENATOR JANSSEN: Okay. Well, thank you, Senator Coordsen, and that's all I have, Mr. Lieutenant Governor.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. (Visitors introduced.) Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to close. Senator Coordsen waives closing. The question is the adoption of the Coordsen amendment to LB 419. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is adopted.
