CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of
LB 950.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 950 does advance to E & R
Initial. Mr. Clerk, next item?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 950A, by Senator Byars. (Read
title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on LB 950A.

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. No need to
elaborate. I think we've discussed this fairly clearly and
in depth. It's an appropriation bill to appropriate \$202,000 in
General Funds and federal funds from...to provide Medicaid
support in setting up the system. I would ask your advancement
for LB 950A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We're discussing the advancement of LB 950A.
Senator Byars, there are no lights. Did you wish to close? He
waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 950A
be advanced to E & R Initial? All those in favor vote aye,
opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please,
Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of
LB 950A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 950A does advance to E & R
Initial. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. A new A bill, LB 957A by
Senator Dierks. (Read LB 957A by title for the first time.) I
have a Judiciary Committee confirmation hearing report signed by
Senator Brashear. Priority bill designations: Revenue Committee
has selected LB 1138 as one of its priority bills; Senator
Dierks selected LB 833 as his personal priority; Senator Don
Pederson, LB 1003 as his priority bill. A series of reports,
Mr. President. Your Committee on Judiciary reports LB 994 to
General File, and the following bills indefinitely postponed:
