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you like to provide a brief recap of where we're at?

SENATOR BROMM: Sure. Thank you, Lieutenant Governor. Yesterday, we divided AM2348 into two parts. This dealt with page 12 of the bill and page 15 of the bill, a little bit on page 17. And we adopted both of those parts. We then offered AM2426 and, Mr. Clerk, I'm pretty sure we adopted AM2426. I'd like to confirm that with the Clerk, but...Mr. Clerk,...

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR BROMM: ...AM2426, was that adopted yesterday?

CLERK: Yes, sir, it was.

SENATOR BROMM: Okay. So, thank you. So, colleagues, Lieutenant Governor, at this point we have adopted any proposed amendments. And I think at this point there may be...there may be another amendment or others offered. I will simply, while people are thinking about what they want to do with the bill, if it's permissible, I'll talk just a little bit more about the general status of the bill. The general purpose of the bill, as was outlined at the beginning, was to provide procedure for where a manufacturer or distributor attempts to acquire an interest in or control dealerships within the state of Nebraska and provides that they shall not do that, except under certain limited circumstances, where they are trying to help someone who financially is unable to handle the obligations, they can get involved and help a franchisee get started. They can own a franchise while it's in a transition of being resold, in good faith, to another party. That is perfectly permissible. The other key, the key provision in the bill is that if an automobile is sold outside the state but it provides for delivery within the state, then it has to be...it has to be subject to and is subject to all of our dealer licensing applicable laws. And the dealer that it's delivered through must agree to be jointly and severally liable with the seller for compliance with the laws and contracts that affect that transaction. So that is kind of where we're at and will be glad to entertain comments or questions. Thank you.
