PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 504.

CLERK: (Read LB 504 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 735.) 41 ayes, 0 nays, 8 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 510.

CLERK: (Read LB 510 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would ask for a roll call vote. I will begin with a call of the house, although we're virtually under call, so I'll just take the roll call vote.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 735-736.) 24 ayes, 17 nays on the final passage of LB 510, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is not passed. Members, pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 626 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, to dispense with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk, please read the title.

CLERK: (Read LB 626 by title.)
