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\$550,000 here which is a half a million dollars, and I think that's a lot of money, It could be used...this money is supposed to be...it would be going for in-services and for tuitioning...to help tuition for those people who can't afford it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator,...

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: I would...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...oh, go ahead.

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: I'd hate like the dickens to lose the bill for this much money but I am talking with the people that I'm carrying the bill for at this point to see where they are at on this.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Pedersen, this money that we're talking about that would come from this \$2 fee is to be used did you say for in-service training and tuition costs?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: For those who can't afford tuition, yes, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do lawyers have to pay for their training?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Do doctors?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Are you a counselor, Senator Dwite Pedersen?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Yes, I am a substance abuse counselor.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did you pay for your training?

SENATOR Dw. PEDERSEN: Every bit of it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If you engage in continuing education, whatever that might consist of, who pays for that?
