SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. President. Just a comment on behalf of Senator, former Senator Witek, I'm sure she would appreciate the kind of words that Senator Chambers produced here today. I also want to say that I want to really add that I think that it's been expressed here that Senator Witek has done an excellent job in trying to get that office back in shape, and this is just one area that needed some cleanup, and she should be applauded for her willingness to work on these issues that in fact will make a difference in that office for those that come after her. I think that we need to understand that. And I do appreciate on behalf of her the things that have been said here this morning. So, with that, I would just ask that you advance the bill. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the adoption of AM2316 to LB 692. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Vrtiska's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Kristensen, AM2285 with a note that he'd like to withdraw, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection? It is withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 692 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 692. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
