SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the advancement of LB 717. All those in favor say aye. Those opposed say nay. It is advanced. LB 717A.

CLERK: LB 717A, no E & R. Senator Preister would move to amend with AM2543. (AM2543, Legislative Journal page 809.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Preister, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, honorable President. This...this amendment takes into account the cost for administration of the program. It was a fiscal note that was put together by our Military Department. They had some additional fees that were in their original A bill. It has been reduced from what they had originally proposed by the Fiscal Office and I think accurately so. This would be an additional \$16,040 that would cover the cost of personnel to administer the statewide LEPC distribution and program. So the amendment adds the additional amount to the appropriation. It would be an additional \$16,040. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Preister, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Preister amendment to LB 717A. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Preister's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
