CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1005.)
40 ayes, 0 nays, 9 excused and not voting, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: LB 74 passes. LB 692.

CLERK: (Read LB 692 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure
having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill with
the emer...excuse me, shall the bill pass? All in favor vote
aye, opposed (microphone malfunction). Record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1006.)
43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting.

SENATOR CROSBY: LB 692 passes. LB 1258E.

CLERK: (Read LB 1258 on Final Reading.)

SENATOR CROSBY: All provisions of law relative to procedure
having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill, with
the emergency clause attached, pass? All in favor vote aye,
opposed no. Have you all voted? Mr. Clerk, record, please.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1006-1007.)
43 ayes, 0 nays, 6 excused and not voting, Madam President.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill passes. LB 438.

CLERK: Madam President, with respect to LB 438, Senator
Redfield, I have an amendment, Senator, AM2452, but I have a
note you want to withdraw AM2452, Senator.

SENATOR CROSBY: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Redfield would move to return
for AM2490. (AM2490, Legislative Journal page 760.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Redfield, to open.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Senator Crosby, members of the
