think that's too burdensome. We are certainly taking on far more responsibility than that when we run for a public office and we want to be accountable to the public for everything we do. So I think this is the least that we can do to assure the public that we are responsible; that in fact we have met the deadlines, we have filed our paperwork, and we have told the public what we have done with funds given to us. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. You've heard the closing. The motion is to return to Select File for specific amendment. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the motion to return the bill.

SENATOR CROSBY: The bill is returned. Senator...Senator Redfield, you may speak about your amendment, open on your amendment.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Senator. I believe that we have spent enough time on this. I think that everyone understands. Unless there are more questions, I would ask us to go ahead and vote. Thank you.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you. Any further discussion on the amendment, AM2490? Seeing none, Senator Redfield? She waives closing. The question is the adoption of the amendment to LB 438. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 41 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted. Is there any discussion before we re-advance the bill? Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Madam President, I move the advancement of LB 438 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CROSBY: You've heard the motion to advance LB 438 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed no. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk.
