SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Senator Preister. You've heard the closing. The question is the adoption of the amendment, AM2748, to LB 957. All in favor vote aye, opposed no. Record, please.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Madam President, on the adoption of Senator Landis' amendment.

SENATOR CROSBY: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Senator Dierks would move to amend. (FA317, Legislative Journal page 1013.)

SENATOR CROSBY: Senator Dierks, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Madam President and members of the Legislature. Mr. Clerk, is this the amendment that changes the name from Natural Resources Commission to Director of Natural Resources?

CLERK: Yes, sir.

SENATOR DIERKS: Okay, we found...members of the Legislature, we found, actually Senator Beutler found, an error in the amendment that we just talked about that we just overlooked, so this is somewhat of a technical amendment. On page 931 in your Journal, if you would look down on line...the first line 16, where it talks about ag producer...it is in the interest of ag producers and the public in general that the Nebraska Natural Resources Commission document and quantify, we're changing that from the Nebraska Natural Resources Commission to the Director of Natural Resources, so that it would read then: it is in the interest of agricultural producers and the public in general that the Nebraska Director of Natural Resources document and quantify, et cetera. Simply a technical amendment to bring the language up to snuff with the rest of the amendment. Thank you.
