SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning we have with us the Reverend Robert Rademacher, of the Lutheran Parish Immanuel of Orum and Emmaus, from Kennard, and this is Senator Connealy's district. (Visitor introduced.) Welcome this morning and would you please stand.

REVEREND RADEMACHER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Reverend Rademacher, for being with us; we really appreciate it. I now call the forty-second day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislative Session in order. Senators, please record your presence.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You have corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: No corrections, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Your Committee on Revenue reports LB 936, LB 1223, LB 1255, and LB 1330 to General File with committee amendments attached. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1025-1026.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, first agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1107, on Select File. E & R amendments have been adopted. Amendment by Senator Wickersham has been adopted. The Legislature adjourned with Senator Raikes having an amendment pending, AM2766, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal page 1017.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, would you like to just kind of tell us where we are, unless Senator Wickersham would like to, one of you. Would you like to fill us in on the...on the bill first, Senator Wickersham, and then Senator Raikes can fill us in on his amendment.
