the limit, then the current director has the authority to undo it or to make such changes as he deems necessary. The purpose of this bill, I think, is to regularize things and I think that one of two things should happen, either an inquiry should be made as to the propriety of the actions taken by the previous director or the present director should act in that director's own accord. Having said that, I will reiterate, I don't think it's a bad bill and I certainly would go along with a study, and I go along with the purpose of the bill. I just want to make the point. And with that, I will say no more. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Tyson. Senator Beutler, on the committee amendments.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Lieutenant Governor, I would move to adjourn. I think this bill is going to take some fresh thought.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk, items for the record?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Raikes, an amendment to LB 925 to be printed; Senator Thompson, amendment to LB 1399. That's all that I have at this time, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1074-1075.)
