ASSISTANT CLERK: The first motion, Mr. President, is the motion to dispense with the at-large reading.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The question before the body is the dispensing of the at-large reading. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 36 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to dispense with the at-large reading.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The at-large reading is dispensed with. LB 1192E.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1192 by title.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: All provisions of law having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 1192 with the emergency clause pass? All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1115-1116.) The vote is 43 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 4 excused and not voting.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: LB 1192E passes. We're going to pass over LB 1135 and proceed down to LB 930.

ASSISTANT CLERK: The first motion, Mr. President, is the motion to dispense with the at-large reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is, shall LB 930 reading be dispensed? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Madam Clerk, please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 37 ayes, 2 nays on the motion to dispense with Final Reading, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Final Reading is dispensed with. Madam Clerk, please read the title.
