PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Kiel. The question is the adoption of AM2856 to LB 1363. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Kiel's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate on the advancement of LB 1363? Senator Connealy, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR CONNEALY: Just hope you can support this. It's a small step, but I think it's a continuation of the work that we've been doing and it shows that the state's looking ahead.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Connealy. The question is the advancement of LB 1363. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1363.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1363A, by Senator Connealy. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Connealy, you are recognized to open on the A bill to LB 1363.

SENATOR CONNEALY: This A bill would provide the \$25,000 over the two-year period. It would be a little bit under \$8,000 the second year, and I'm trying to see the number, \$17,642 the first year.
