SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Suttle. We are now open for discussion on the advancement of LB 1427A. Senator Chambers, you're recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I'd like to ask Senator Suttle a question or two, if I may.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you respond, Senator Suttle?

SENATOR SUTTLE: Oh, I'd love to.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Suttle, you know how to extract fangs, but still I'm going to ask you the question. Has there been any indication from the Governor of objection to this bill?

SENATOR SUTTLE: No, because there's no General Funds involved.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Seeing no further lights, the question before the body is, shall LB 1427A be advanced to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1427A.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1427A does advance. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1124, is a bill by Senator Coordsen and a number of members. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 10 of this year, referred to the Revenue Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President.
