SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good morning and welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. This morning we have with us the Reverend Nancy Flader from the First United Methodist Church in Blair, Nebraska. That is Senator Connealy's district. Reverend Flader.

REVEREND FLADER: (Prayer offered.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Reverend Flader, for being with us. It's appreciated. I do call the forty-seventh day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, Second Session to order. Senators, please record your presence. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Messages, reports or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, at this time, I have no messages, reports or announcements.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, General File. LB 352A. It's a bill by Senator Crosby. (Read title.) I do have an amendment to the bill by Senator Crosby. (AM2931, Legislative Journal page 1188.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Crosby, you're recognized to open on LB 352A.

SENATOR CROSBY: Thank you, Mr. President and members. LB 352A is the A bill that transfers the Rehabilitation Services for the Visually Impaired, RSVI, from the Health and Human Services System to the Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired. All funds currently appropriated to RSVI are transferred in this bill to the new agency. It includes state funds, federal, and
