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funding available. And I'm not going to get any...he says I don't have any excitement about this. I have a lot of excitement about this bill, but I had a feeling that I was going to run into opposition from Senator Chambers because he had so much as indicated to me that he was going to try to defeat this bill and, again, that's his privilege. On the other hand, I'm going to do everything I can to convince this body that this is important to rural Nebraska and the people that I represent, the people that have come to me and are excited about an opportunity to start up in a value-added type product that will enhance their income and, as a result in enhancing the income, will certainly enhance the entire state. That's what many of these things are about. This isn't a lot of money. This is just enough money to encourage somebody who is trying to find a way to open up some small operation that will, in fact, enhance their income and keep them down on the farm and in these small towns where these kind of operations will exist out of. I think it's important to address these kinds of issues. We didn't come in here asking for a million, two million, three million dollars. Maybe we should have and, originally, I had talked about it, but I thought that we'd start out with what I consider somewhat of a pilot program that would see what people were really interested in and how much interest there might be. I found there's a tremendous amount of interest. I've had lots of letters and calls from people who are...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...excited about the opportunity to take advantage of a start-up operation but they're having difficulty finding the financing and the help to do. It's not going to be IBP or big corporate America taking over the state. It's going to be small operations. And I can name you a great many of them that have gotten started with some difficulty but they are advancing and this can happen over and over again if they get an opportunity, and that's the reason for the bill. I'd hope that you wouldn't support the bracket motion and we would be able to discuss it at length. I want...I'll try to answer any questions that anybody might have, but I still think it's an important piece of legislation and I would hope I could gain the support to not allow the bracket motion to put this bill to sleep.
