themselves in this situation, and we can also economize in terms of judicial resources. The Department of Health and Human Services supported LB 920 in committee. The Health and Human Services Committee advanced the bill 7-0. It was, at one time, recommended for consent calendar and was also a part of LB 1115 yesterday, before we reconfigured it. And I would urge the return of LB 1352 to Select File for the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I just rise in support of the return to Select File for this specific amendment. It is something that needs to be done, and if it fits in, which it looks like it does, to this bill, I have no problem with it. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: I only want to express my appreciation to Senator Janssen for his concurrence in this procedure and ask for the return and adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator. The question is, shall LB 1352 be returned to Select File for specific amendment? Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Please record.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on AM3064.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, members of the body, I would request the adoption of the amendment for the reasons stated. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Debate. Senator Brashear, you're recognized to close. Closing is waived. The question is the adoption of AM3064 to LB 1352.
