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programs that are known to be inferior to other types of programs in terms of their economic development effect, so I think, if you're interested in coordinated government and you're interested in efficient government, and you're interested in everybody working together, that what makes sense is to do in the Economic Development Department the things that we created the department to do, that is to guide economic development, whatever kind of economic development it may be. So I would still strongly recommend the amendment to you. It seems like a small consideration...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...for the overall program, and remind you the Microenterprise part of the bill is going to Department of Economic Development. What's the difference? I don't understand a big difference there. And again, if you approve of the amendment, certainly I would be glad to quickly add phraseology requiring consultation with the Department of Agriculture, that would make sense. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Beutler amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Roll call vote, call of the house.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: There's been a request for a call of the house. All those in favor of placing the house under call vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Record.

CLERK: 24 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.
