SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Beutler, I had a request from Senator Dierks for reverse order.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Oh, okay.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Sorry. All members are here. There's been a roll call. Members, before we do the roll call, I would suggest if we're going to make a request of the Chair from now on for which order, that I'll only do that by recognizing someone at the mike, so that everybody has a chance to know who's done that. That will be the practice in the future. Thank you. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1428.)
13 ayes, 27 nays on the amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is not adopted. I raise the call. Next item.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 1348 to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Question before the body is the advancement of LB 1348 to E & R for engrossing. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. There has been a record vote requested. We're voting on the advancement of LB 1348. Have you all voted who care to? Please record.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1428-1429.)
32 ayes, 2 nays on the advancement, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The bill advances. We next move to LB 1119. Mr. Clerk. Excuse me, there is an A bill, LB 1348A.
