E & R. Senator Wehrbein has an amendment, but I understand you want to withdraw AM3000, Senator.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kiel had an amendment, but I understand she wishes to withdraw.

SENATOR KIEL: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wehrbein would move to amend with AM3122. (Legislative Journal page 1429.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, this is the...this A bill reflects the way I indicated the amendment was drafted. It's \$1 million a year for three years and \$250,000 a year for the Microenterprise Funds, so it's \$1,250,000, which is significantly reduced from the original A bill, which was a total of \$3.650 million, \$3,650,000. This totals \$1,250,000 for the three years only. Of course that last two will have to be reappropriated, but that...this reflects the updated A bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the amendment? Debate on the amendment? Seeing none, Senator Wehrbein, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. Question before the body is the adoption of AM3122. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advance...or adoption of Senator Wehrbein's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Smith, you're recognized for a motion to advance.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB 1348A
