PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the fifty-fifth day of the Ninety-Sixth Legislature, Second Session. Our chaplain this morning is Pastor R.D. Fowler of the Bethel Baptist Church in...here in Lincoln, Senator Raikes' district. Pastor.

PASTOR FOWLER: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Pastor. Members, if you'll report to the Chamber, record your presence, we'll begin today's business. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Corrections for the Journal?

CLERK: I have no corrections this morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Messages, reports, or announcements?

CLERK: Mr. President, LR 451 and LR 482 are ready for your signature, and that's all that I have this morning, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I propose to sign and do sign LR 451 and LR 482. Mr. Clerk, General File appropriation bills.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 833A by Senator Dierks. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Dierks, you're recognized to open.

SENATOR DIERKS: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. LB 833A would provide the Cash Fund expenditure necessary for the Department of Health Regulations and Licensure to carry out LB 833 as it had been amended. The bill authorizes the expenditure of \$18,924 in the Bureau of Examining Board Cash
