PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Landis. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hilgert would move to amend with AM2751. (AM2751, Legislative Journal page 1540.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Bourne, I understand you're authorized to handle the amendment for Senator Hilgert?

SENATOR BOURNE: Yes, I am, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: You're recognized to open.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you. Members, this bill just simply reflects the additional savings to the state that is reflected by 9...LB 914 being incorporated in LB 925, which, as I understand it, reduces the A bill by roughly \$1.5 million.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Bourne. Discussion on the amendment, AM2751, to LB 925A? Senator Bourne, you're recognized to close. Senator Bourne waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM2751 to LB 925A. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hilgert's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Debate on the advancement of LB 925A? Senator Landis, you're recognized to close. Senator Landis waives closing. The question is the advancement of LB 925A. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 925A.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk, items for the record.
