CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers, I now have your motion, Senator, to indefinitely postpone the bill. Senator Wickersham, you would have the option to lay the bill over.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: I will lay the bill over.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The bill is laid over. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item. Items for the record, Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Thank you, Mr. President. Mr. President, items for the record, thank you. LR 496 is a resolution by Senator Lynch. It will be laid over. Senator Hilgert has an amendment to LB 925 to be printed, Mr. President. (Legislative Journal pages 1611-1612.)

Mr. President, the next bill for consideration, LB 1010. Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1010.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 1010.

CLERK: Senator, I'm sorry, we've adopted the E & Rs apparently. I'm mistaken so forgive me. I think, Mr. President, where we are with LB 1010, Senator Kristensen had pending AM3231.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen, would you like to fill us in on that amendment, AM3231.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Yes, Mr. President, I will. I'll only just take a minute. As you all know, this is the educational lands and funds bill.
