SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Yes, I'll yield time to Senator Schrock.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Nobody wants the time. Senator Schrock, your light is next if you wish to speak.

SENATOR SCHROCK: I don't have any problem with the Wickersham amendment, if that's what you're asking me. And, Senator Beutler, it's okay with you?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Works for me then. And it's clarifying language, as far as I'm concerned.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There are no further lights on. Senator Wickersham, do you wish to close on your amendment? Senator Wickersham waives closing. The question before the body is the Wickersham amendment to AM3324 to LB 1234. All in favor of the Wickersham amendment vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the Wickersham amendment to the Schrock amendment. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the Wickersham amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Wickersham amendment is adopted. Senator Schrock, there are no lights on. Did you wish to close on your amendment?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Just a reminder to the body that this amendment contains two bills that were on...were on file this morning, on General File this morning. They were Speaker priority bills. One is the Niobrara River Council. The other is the wastewater treatment issue that was brought to us by DEQ. They already can give grants and loans to counties for...for municipal...for cleanup in case of natural disasters. They don't have the authority to do that for municipalities. This gives them that authority.
