SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the Legislature, according to the agenda you'll see under Select File here it says that the Speaker will determine length of time under this section. That was dependent upon the number of bills that was going to be passed over from the Select File on the top of the agenda. Given that, we'll be here till about 12:15 and then it would...at that point in time, we're going to move to the senator priority bills. It would be my hope that we could accomplish the senator priority bills on Select File by the end of today and call it a successful week. So we'll be here for...till 12:15 and, if we get done within that hour on Select File then we'll just move down the agenda and go to those 2000 senator priority bills. Most all of those were completed last night. We would begin the Select File on the 2000 senator priority bills with LB 925. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Mr. Clerk, LB 825.

CLERK: Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator. (AM7261, Legislative Journal page 1495.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 825.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 9...825. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Price would move to amend the bill, Mr. President. (AM3238, Legislative Journal page 1544.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Price, recognized to open.

SENATOR PRICE: Mr. Lieutenant Governor and members of the body, there is a technical amendment that was recommended after the bill had advanced to Select File and that's all the comments that I would have.
