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SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Well, Mr. President, I might spend just a couple of minutes here because I think Senator Coordsen has indicated that he has an amendment drafted along the lines that he was asking me about. And I'm not sure how long it's going to take to get that amendment down, but that doesn't seem to me like it's an unworkable definition. It is broader, certainly, than the definition that we have been working on because it would include in that instance aunts, uncles and cousins, people that I indicated were not included here. And I think I saw...must be a magic amendment just being handed to Senator Coordsen, or at least provisions out of the existing statute in Chapter 21, I take it. But, Senator Coordsen, I would yield to you the balance of my time, if you want to discuss your concept further.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank...thank you...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Coordsen.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Actually, I do not have an amendment drafted. What I do have is statutory site 21-1710, which says, immediate family shall include any person related to a member, in this case, by blood or marriage, including foster and adopted children. It would be my position that, with a little bit of a floor amendment, that we could probably create something that would be more workable. But I do not have an amendment drafted at the time. Thank you, Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, you're recognized.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, Senator Coordsen, I turned my light on so you might have some time to work on that amendment. My...my concern would be that it would be in language that the ordinary layperson (laugh) could understand, and it sounds as if it is. I wasn't listening to your original explanation, but I believe it is. And I would...I guess I'll go ahead and talk about what we've done here today a little bit, and give them a little bit of time. If anybody else would like some time to speak, like maybe the sponsor of this bill or somebody like that, this would be an excellent time, Senator Chambers. (Laughter) But anyway, I will reiterate for us, while they're doing that, what the
