PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1708.) The vote is 44 ayes, 0 nays, 4 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. LB 956.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 956 on Final Reading.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Have you voted? Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 1709.) The vote is 44 ayes, 1 nay, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is passed. (Visitors introduced.) Members, pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8, the question is, shall LB 1003 be considered for a vote without an at-large reading? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 39 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on dispensing with Final Reading.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is agreed to. Madam Clerk, please read the title.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Read LB 1003 by title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 1709-1710.) The vote is 46 ayes, 0 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.
