LB 438 as amended would authorize the Department of Agriculture to: 1) develop a statewide livestock emergency response system; 2) conduct surveillance to monitor disease control and eradication; 3) provide a voluntary livestock certification program and a livestock certification registry; 4) adopt rules and regulations regarding the best management practices for the burial of dead animals; and 5) register research or demonstration facilities designated for innovative livestock disposal methods. If the Department registers research and demonstration facilities, there may be additional costs to the agency. It is estimated that the costs could be absorbed by existing budgetary resources.
