6 WHEREAS, Brayden McLaughlin has earned the rank of Eagle
7 Scout, that organization's highest rank; and

8 WHEREAS, Brayden McLaughlin has been active in Boy Scout
9 Troop 54, Cathedral of the Risen Christ, in Lincoln, Nebraska,
10 since March 1994; and

11 WHEREAS, for his Eagle Scout project, Brayden McLaughlin
12 planned, obtained specifications, and acquired necessary permits
13 and permission to landscape a flower garden on the grounds of the
14 Mother House of Christ The King Nuns at Denton, Nebraska; and

15 WHEREAS, fewer than four percent of all boys who join the
16 Boy Scouts attain the rank of Eagle Scout; and

17 WHEREAS, Brayden McLaughlin has achieved great success as
18 an exemplary member of the Scouting program and has represented his
19 troop and community with excellence; and

20 WHEREAS, a Court of Honor ceremony will be held on
21 Sunday, June 10, 2001, at the Cathedral of the Risen Christ
22 Catholic Church, at which time Brayden McLaughlin will receive his
23 Eagle Scout medal.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE
25 NINETY-SEVENTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

26 1. That the Legislature commends Brayden McLaughlin for

1 his dedication, hard work, and perseverance in obtaining his Eagle
2 Scout rank.
