6 WHEREAS, the North Bend Central High School boys' track  
7 team is the 2001 Class B state champion; and

8 WHEREAS, the North Bend Tigers boys' track team won the  
9 team title with 71 points, which is 12 more points than the point  
10 total posted by second-place Seward High School; and

11 WHEREAS, this is the first boys' team state championship  
12 in any sport for the North Bend Tigers; and

13 WHEREAS, the North Bend Tigers team was assisted by the  
14 first place wins of: Mark Richardson in the 800-meter run; Matt  
15 Hampl in the pole vault; Jeff Phelps in the 400-meter and 200-meter  
16 runs; and the 4 x 100 meter relay team consisting of Jeff Phelps,  
17 Chris Witthuhn, Syd Hamilton, and Jason Wehner; and

18 WHEREAS, the North Bend Tigers boys' track team displayed  
19 the many qualities that are important in a championship track team,  
20 including perseverance, dedication, effort, sportsmanship, and  
21 teamwork; and

22 WHEREAS, the whole community of North Bend should be  
23 proud of its support of the young men who are members of the state  
24 champion boys' track team and their coaches Fred Lambley, Tony  
25 Allgood, Rick Watson, and Steve Richardson.
