The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 465 is to repeal a statute that provides for judicial interpretation of the burden of proof faced by property owners seeking to reverse a decision of the county board of equalization, and to allow the TERC to appoint referees to mediate property tax disputes.
