

LEGISLATIVE BILL 317

Approved by the Governor February 20, 2001

Introduced by Brown, 6

AN ACT relating to cities of the metropolitan class; to amend section 14-510, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to authorize adoption of an imprest system of accounting; and to repeal the original section.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 14-510, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

14-510. (1) Warrants of the city shall be drawn by the comptroller upon the treasurer and shall be signed by the mayor and comptroller and shall state the particular fund or appropriation to which the same is chargeable and the person to whom payable. Money of the city shall not be otherwise paid except in instances where it is otherwise specifically provided.

(2) The city may adopt by ordinance an imprest system of accounting for the city and authorize the establishment of an imprest vendor, payroll, or other account for the payment of city warrants in accordance with any guidelines issued by the Auditor of Public Accounts for county imprest accounts.

Sec. 2. Original section 14-510, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
