Isn't that interesting. They thought the files were there when we asked for them. They said, well, they're right over there, just go look for them; so where? We can't find them. Oh, gee, I guess they're not here; sorry about that; we'll see if we can find them. State Patrol can't find them either. I urge you to vote against this bill. This is a bad piece of legislation, it does not deserve this much time. We can ill-afford to take this gamble with the lives of our children. I urge the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.
