process of a number of amendments to the committee amendments. But where we're at right now, basically after the introduction, is LB 114 would add the word "consumption" or would add consumption to the prohibited activities to the present minor-in-consumption laws. In addition to that, LB 114 would also add for some additional penalties for an underage person who would be convicted of either minor in possession or minor in consuming alcohol, which could include a license suspension or a license impoundment if the minor's sentence was suspended or if he was placed on probation. Like I said, there's been a number of amendments, some of them adopted, some of them haven't, and I think where we're at today is Senator Chambers has some additional amendments that he would propose to the committee amendments. And that's just kind of a short update on where we are today.
