PRESIDENT MAURSTAD PRESIDING

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Good morning. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber for the forty-sixth day of the Ninety-Seventh Legislature. Our chaplain of the day is Pastor Todd Karges of the First United Methodist Church in Lexington, Nebraska, Senator Cudaback's district. Pastor.

PASTOR KARGES: (Prayer offered.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Pastor Karges. The Nebraska Legislature is called to order. Members, please report to the Legislature and record your presence. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.
