Senator Suttle's amendment which we adopted the last time we talked about this. And that pretty much is what the amendment does. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Hudkins. Debate on the Hudkins amendment? Senator Hudkins, you're recognized to close. Senator Hudkins waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM0567 to LB 254. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Hudkins' amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Erdman.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you. I move the advancement of LB 254 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The question is the advancement of LB 254 to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 483, the next bill. Senator Hartnett has the first amendment, FA88.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator...

SENATOR HARTNETT: I would withdraw that amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection, the amendment is withdrawn.
